SAFETY REPORT BY BRUCE LOCKWOOD

Well here we are and 2009 is quickly upon us. Soon (okay in a few short months) we should see some good riding temperatures again, but in the meantime there are a few things we can do to get ready for the upcoming riding season. As your bike is sitting in the "cold" storage, make sure that your tires are kept inflated to the proper air pressure so that no extra side wall pressure is being applied to the tires. And at the same time check the tires for proper tread depth and cracking (checking) of the tires. Now make sure to clean the battery terminals and if available connect a battery tender to the battery to keep it charged up during the storage season.
